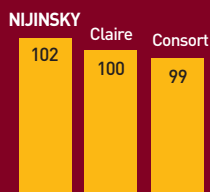

HIGH YIELDING

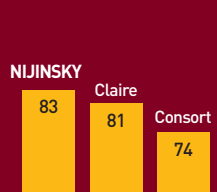
TREATED YIELD
